In the summer of 2021, the Guyot family will present new restored rooms of the castle and new Escape game tours for adults and children.







NEW PANORAMIC TOURS

to gain height



Visit the troglodytic fort of La Roque Gageac:

This surprising new place, clinging to the cliff and overlooking the Dordogne River, offers a modern museography around portraits of personalities who have marked the history of the region and a breath-taking view of the Dordogne Valley.

The unusual ascent to the top of the emblematic Saint-Front cathedral in Périgueux :

In small group and accompanied, the visit of the roofs of the cathedral reserves a 360-degree panorama of the city of Périgueux. Inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List under the Ways of Santiago de Compostela, the cathedral is a jewel that is inspired by Byzantine Romanesque architecture, recognizable by its domes enhanced with bells.

Aged in Monbazillac barrels, this cognac is enriched by the specific notes of this sweet wine. The production « small batch », revived by the House CAMUS, comes from the vineyard of Saint-Aulaye Puymangou, charming perigordian village classified « Small town of character » in right to use the appellation Cognac.

Gins and vodkas « Erika Spirit »

Manufactured « Made in Bergerac », this artisanal gin sets out to conquer the world of spirits flavoured with juniper. Based on local botanical plants and heather honey, the small brand that goes up offers a range of four gins and tries vodka, VODKA NEUVIK.

GRINDING MILLS

still turning



Witnesses of peasant life, they have so many secrets to tell us!

The miller of the Moulin de l'Evêque in Vézac does not sleep! Elie COUSTATY, dressed as a former miller, produces all kinds of organic flours, in collaboration with local grain producers (rye from Cénac, einkorn wheat from Pressignac, etc.).

At the Moulin de Landry in Chantérac, Nicolas POMMIER perpetuates the artisanal manufacture of walnut oil, as well as another ancestral sweetness: the old-fashioned waffles of the Périgord. New member of the \upomega Route de la noix du Périgord \upomega , this old water mill is open to visit.



Picnic on the beaches of Limeuil, take a nap at the foot of a medieval castle... the Volkswagen California van will turn into a berth at night, to wake you up in the heart of the vineyard of Bergerac or at the top of the cliff of Domme.

Safe steps in the classified campsites: Stopping for the night in a classified campsite remains however an excellent alternative. Most campsites have suitable pitches for camper vans. So you can enjoy the sanitary facilities essential for your comfort like hot shower and toilet!





In 2020, the downstream route of the valley, from Terrasson-Lavilledieu to Limeuil, obtained the label « Grand Site de France » (2nd labelled site in Nouvelle-Aquitaine with the Marais poitevin).

In 2021 The Human Valley is committed to sustainable tourism and new ecochartered offers are born.

18 electric bikes are available for rent in 4 stations in the valley. Whatever your level of cycling, it will be easy for you to travel the 3 routes selected in the heart of natural landscapes and emblematic prehistoric sites.

HIKING «IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF AMADOUR»

from the Atlantic Ocean to the Causses du Quercy



Discover the high places of pilgrimage following the river Dordogne.

This new hiking trail offers walking in the footsteps of the legend of Saint Amadour. It connects the 4 departments (Gironde, Lot-et-Garonne, Dordogne and Lot), which would have been crossed by the hermit to retire in a cave of Rocamadour. There are no less than 400 km of hiking trails to explore!

During the 150 km in the Dordogne, in the heart of the largest biosphere reserve of France, will succeed beautiful landscapes and views, unmissable visits (the Abbey of Cadouin) and villages of characters.



Better to meet and return to the essentials with our loved ones, leave our concerns far behind us, being pampered, accompanied, surprised and seduced.


